## Open Calls

On the 3rd of September several FP7 calls have been published. Among them the FP7-SSH-2009 call was published with a deadline of 13 January 2009 at 17:00:00 Brussels local time.

The call is divided into 3:

### Call identifier: FP7-SSH-2009-A

Budget: € 55 million

Types of projects:

- Collaborative research projects (≤2.7 M€ per project)
- Research for the Benefit of Specific Groups - Civil Society Organisations (CSO) (≤ 1.0 M€ per project)

**Call Identifier: FP7-SSH-2009-B**

Budget: € 6 million

Type of projects: Collaborative projects (small or medium-scale focused research projects) for specific cooperation actions dedicated to international cooperation ( $\leq 3.0$  M€ per project)

**Call Identifier: FP7-SSH-2009-C**

Budget: € 6.22 million

Type of projects: Coordination and support actions.

In addition to the specific call for SSH, topics with relevance to SSH can be found in other themes' work programmes:

- Theme 1: Health (publication: 3 September 2008)
- Theme 2: Food, Agriculture and Fisheries, Biotechnology (publication: 3 September 2008)
- Theme 3: Information and Communication Technologies (publication: 27 November 2008)
- Theme 6: Environment (publication 3 September 2008)
- Theme 10: Security (publication 3 September 2008)
